 Tracing the Theme of Emotional Burden

A central theme in *The Things They Carried* is emotional burden. Find ten instances of this theme in the novel. Then:

In column 1: Record the name of the character the instance focuses on.

In column 2: Record the character's emotional burden.

In column 3: Explain whether the character carried this burden into war or gained it during the war.

After completing the chart, discuss which of the identified emotional burdens would be the hardest to carry. Give evidence to support your opinion.

Character	Emotional Burden	Carried into the War or Caused by the War?
Jimmy Cross	unrequited love for Martha that distracts him from his duty	carried into the war
